

## SACE INTEGRATED PROGRAMS

### Dance Your Way to SACE

In collaboration with Turning Point Dance, this program is for students from Years 10-12 looking for pathways in dance and dance education. ### Film School

40 Stage 1 credits and 70 Stage 2 credits, including the compulsory Research Project.

### Games for SACE Program

30 Stage 1 credits and 20 Stage 2 credits including the compulsory 20 literacy and 10 numeracy credits.

### Head-start to SACE - Integrated Year 10 Program

A semester 2 integrated program designed for Year 10 students that focuses on the development of skills in critical and creative thinking, problem-solving and collaboration to explore real-world issues. Students will gain 40 Stage 1 credits.

### SACE for University

SACE completion that prepares students for University study and attracts an Australian Tertiary Admissions Rank for tertiary entrance.

### SACE for Work

SACE completion that prepares students for the workplace and can attract an Australian Tertiary Admissions Rank for tertiary entrance with the addition of one further Stage 2 subject.

## ENGLISH PROGRAMS

### New Arrivals Program

The New Arrivals Program (NAP) offers intensive English language and literacy courses for students who have been living in Australia for less than 12 months. Students develop an understanding of Australian culture and gain knowledge of educational and career choices whilst improving their English language skills.

### English Proficiency Certificates

The Certificates in English Proficiency are nationally accredited courses designed for people from non-English speaking backgrounds who wish to develop the English skills necessary for living, working and/or studying in Australia.
