Welcome to Thebarton Senior College for 2022. **Year 11 classes will be commencing online on Wednesday 2 February.** This letter contains important information about starting dates and arrangements for classes this year.

YEAR 11 INDUCTION

Please come to the college gym on Tuesday 1 February to collect your timetable, diary, student identification card and passwords and to ensure that you are able to access online learning from home. If you have your own laptop, please bring this with you on the day to make sure that you can access the college portal, email system and online learning platform (Moodle) from home. If you don't have access to a computer at home, you will be able to borrow a college laptop on the day. If you are unable to come in on Tuesday 1 February, there will be a Information Desk set up in the Walsh building foyer on Wednesday 2 and Thursday 3 February.

YEAR 11 (SACE Stage 1) CLASSES - start online on Wednesday 2 February

Year 11 (SACE Stage 1) classes will be starting online according to your timetable. Your class teachers will provide information to you about accessing online learning via your college email address. Please check your college emails regularly.

YEAR 12 CLASSES - start face-to-face on Wednesday 2 February

If you are studying a year 12 (SACE Stage 2) subject, these classes will commence face-to-face on Wednesday 2 February, so you will need to come in to the college for these classes. If you are at the college for a year 12 class, you can work from the college Study Centre for your year 11 classes if you are unable to get home in time for your online class. If you are studying a Year 12 twilight subject, please meet your teacher at Reception prior to 4.00 pm on the first day of your twilight class.

Minimising the spread of COVID-19

To ensure that our students and staff are as safe as possible at the college, we will be implementing the following measures as advised by the Department for Education and SA Health:
