## SACE SUBJECT PACKAGES

### Film School

This package of three Stage 2 subjects allows students to explore film making, while learning specific skills relevant to working in a variety of roles within the industry.

### Games for SACE Program

This program provides students with the opportunity to achieve all Stage 1 compulsory requirements through engaging with and studying video games.

### Game Design Package

This Stage 2 package is centred around the concepts of Game Design and Development. Students explore and develop the skills to generate Game ideas, design and create prototypes using industry standard tools.

### Mathematics Academy

This Stage 1 program is for students especially interested and excited about mathematics and intending to study Stage 2 Mathematical Methods, Specialist Mathematics and Physics.

### SACE for University Program

This Stage 2 program gives students the opportunity to complete their SACE and gain an ATAR for tertiary entrance.

### SACE for Work Program

This Stage 2 program prepares students for the world of work and gives students the opportunity to complete their SACE.

### Special Interest Academy

The Special Interest Academy enables students to complete their SACE and/or VET qualifications while pursuing their own passions, interests and commitments, be they entrepreneurial, dancing, sporting, music or performing arts.

### SACE Compulsories

This course is individualised to meet both individual student needs and the requirements of the compulsory Stage 1 SACE subjects: English, Mathematics and Personal Learning Plan.

## ENGLISH PROGRAMS

### New Arrivals Program/Intensive English Language Program

This program offers intensive English language and literacy courses for students who have been living in Australia for less than 12 months. Students develop an understanding of Australian culture and gain knowledge of educational and career choices whilst improving their English language skills.

## FURTHER STUDY SKILLS PROGRAM

This program has been designed to prepare students to undertake further study options and develop basic employability skills and knowledge.

It includes nationally accredited competencies from the 10591NAT Certificate II in Further Study Skills which are aimed at preparing students for the challenges of study and work environments.
