SACE SUBJECT PACKAGES

SACE Subject Packages are packages of subjects designed to support students to complete SACE and commence a career pathway.

Digital Media Program

This program encompasses a range of integrated subjects which promote the development of communication, media literacy and digital technology skills. The program is structured around five core subjects and a range of electives. Subjects within the program can be studied individually or as part of a package, giving students flexibility to engage with the content according to their own needs. The program prepares students to become critical, ethical and proficient users and creators of digital media for both professional and personal purposes.

Engineering and Construction Program

This SACE Stage 1 and 2 program has been developed with input from industry partners to prepare students for the engineering and construction industries, with both ATAR and apprenticeship/traineeship pathways.

Games for SACE Program

This program provides students with the opportunity to achieve all Stage 1 compulsory requirements through engaging with and studying video games.

Pathway to Policing

This SACE Stage 2 subject package has been developed to provide a pathway to a career in policing. If you are interested in applying for a role as a police officer with SA Police, then this package can help you to prepare for SA Police's eligibility criteria and recruitment process, by developing the skills and qualities needed for this rewarding career.

SACE Compulsories

This course is individualised to meet both individual student needs and the requirements of the compulsory Stage 1 SACE subjects: English, Mathematics and Exploring Identities and Futures.

School-based Apprentice or Trainee (SBAT) Program

This is a SACE Stage 1 and 2 program for school-based apprentices or trainees, which supports both school requirements and employer's needs. The program provides flexible SACE subjects that enables students to complete SACE by attending school one day per week and be employed four days per week in their traineeship or apprenticeship.

Special Interest Academy

The Special Interest Academy enables students to complete their SACE and/or VET qualifications while pursuing their own passions, interests and commitments, be they entrepreneurial, dancing, sporting, music or performing arts.

APPRENTICESHIPS AND TRAINEESHIPS

School-based apprenticeships and traineeships provide opportunities for students to complete their secondary school studies while gaining skills and knowledge through paid employment. Thebarton Senior College supports students seeking a traineeship or apprenticeship in a wide range of industry sectors, such as disability support, early childhood education and care, engineering, construction, education support, electrotechnology, plumbing, information technology, among others.

ENGLISH PROGRAMS

New Arrivals Program/Intensive English Language Program

This program offers intensive English language and literacy courses for students who have been living in Australia for less than 12 months. Students develop an understanding of Australian culture and gain knowledge of educational and career choices whilst improving their English language skills.

Intensive Secondary English Course (ISEC)

This course is for eligible full-fee paying international students. It is designed to assist international students to develop their English proficiency and to familiarise students with studying and living in Australia.

FURTHER STUDY SKILLS PROGRAM

This program has been designed to prepare students to undertake further study options and develop basic employability skills and knowledge.

It includes nationally accredited competencies from the 11041NAT Certificate II in Further Study Skills which are aimed at preparing students for the challenges of study and work environments.
