Welcome to Thebarton Senior College for 2022. This letter contains important information about starting dates for classes this year.

YEAR 12 (SACE Stage 2) DAY CLASSES - start face-to-face on Wednesday 2 February

The gym will be open on Wednesday 2 February from 8.30-9.00 am for you to collect your timetable, diary, student identification card and passwords. After collecting these items, if you have a class in Lesson 1, please go directly to this class, which will commence at 9.15 am.

For students who have classes starting in Lesson 2 or 3 on this day (or who start after Wednesday 2 February), timetables, student identification cards and passwords will be available from the Information Desk in the Walsh building foyer. This Information Desk is also where you can go to get help during the first few days of the year.

YEAR 12 (SACE Stage 2) TWILIGHT CLASSES - start on Wednesday 2 February at 4.00 pm

If you are studying a twilight subject at the college, please meet your teacher at Reception prior to 4.00 pm on the day of your twilight class.

YEAR 11 (SACE Stage 1) CLASSES - start online on Wednesday 2 February

If you are studying a year 11 (SACE Stage 1) subject, these classes will be starting online. Your class teacher will provide information to you via your college email address. You can access these classes from home, or if you are at the college for your year 12 classes, you will be able to work from the Study Centre.

Please bring a notepad and pen to your year 12 classes. Your teachers will provide you with further details about stationery and textbooks required for each class.

Minimising the spread of COVID-19
